LOCATIONS

Both locations are accessible via Metro line 1 and are 23 minutes apart from one another.

ON CAMPUS

Our campus is located near station Pont-de-Bois on Metroline 1. To get to the HARTIS meeting room, please follow the steps below, as indicated on the map:

1. **At station Pont-de-Bois**, walk past the bus stops and go straight until you reach the main road (avenue du Pont de Bois), then turn right.
2. **Climb the stairs to the bridge going over the main road.** Turn left and cross the bridge, go straight, past the forum, until you reach building A.
3. **Enter building A and go down the stairs** (either on the left or straight ahead). When you reach level -1, follow the signage towards “Département Histoire de l’art et archéologie”, “HARTIS”, or “Bibliothèque Georges Lefebvre”. **All the HARTIS rooms can be found in the same two corridors.**
